

Launching *Air Capabilities of the U.S. Navy SEALs*

Captain Olson, with the help of co-writer and fellow SEAL Commander Tom Hawkins, collected many other first-hand accounts and rare, never before published photos of the previously untold history of the secretive world of Naval Special Warfare. *Air Capabilities of the U.S. Navy SEALs* tells the story of individual initiative, personal daring, clever innovation—and a few calamities along the way. This is the first of a three-volume trilogy covering the Sea, Air, and Land capabilities of Navy SEALs and their Underwater Demolition Team precursors.
